PLEASE READ THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE PARTICIPATING IN THE CONTEST AS THEY CONTAIN BINDING LEGAL TERMS AND OBLIGATIONS INCLUDING LIMITATIONS OR EXCLUSION OF OUR LIABILITY. BY PARTICIPATING IN THE CONTEST, YOU ARE DEEMED TO UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN ITS ENTIRETY.

IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO ANY OF THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, YOU MUST NOT PROCEED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONTEST.

Terms & Conditions:

- 1) This Contest is open to all schools in **Vietnam, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Thailand and Singapore** save and except for immediate family members (defined as parents, siblings, children or domestic partners, regardless of where they live) of the employees of the Organiser and the Contest’s sponsor, i.e.: **“SP Setia Berhad”**.
- 2) Participation is through schools only and the respective school’s principal or teacher coordinator shall ensure that the school and its students have obtained the relevant permission from their respective education ministry/authority to participate in the Contest (if applicable). Contest submissions must be stamped and signed by the respective school’s principal or teacher coordinator.
- 3) Each school may submit multiple entries for the Contest but only one (1) school from each country is eligible to win one (1) cash grant of USD 250 only (**“Grant”**). The Grant must be utilized by the winning school for the purposes of this Contest.
- 4) The Contest will commence from 22 February 2019 at 09.00am (GMT+8) and end on 15 March 2019 at 11.59pm (GMT+8) (**“Submission Period”**). Each country’s shortlist evaluation will commence from 18 March 2019 at 7.00 am (GMT+8) to 20 March 2019 at 11.59pm (GMT+8). The final evaluation to facilitate the selection of one (1) Grant winner for each country will be conducted on 21 March 2019 starting at 7.00am (GMT+8) and end at 11.59pm (GMT+8).
- 5) To stand a chance to win the Grant, participating schools shall ensure their students :
 - a) Write a proposal for an activity, event, or programme which the students would like to execute during #StandTogether Kindness Week which will start from 1 April 2019 and end on 13 March 2019 (**“Proposal”**).
 - b) Work on the Proposal either individually or in a group of not more than forty (40) students.

- c) Follow the criteria(s) stated in the official #StandTogether website, more commonly known as “standtogether.my” (“**Contest Site**”).
- 6) The participating schools shall ensure that students submit a report on the execution of their project during #StandTogether Kindness Week by 26 March 2019 at 11.59pm (GMT +8).
- 7) Principals and teacher coordinators are not eligible to participate in the Contest but they may assist their students in their Contest submissions.
- 8) Submission form must be complete failing which such submission will not be considered as a valid Contest entry and will automatically be rejected by the Organiser.
- 9) All submissions must be emailed to the Organiser’s email address at alltherage@thestar.com.my during the Submission Period. Submission submitted through other mediums/methods will not be considered as a valid Contest entry and will automatically be rejected by the Organizer.
- 10) Contest submissions will be judged based on the following criterias:-
 - a) Reasoning of why it is important for the participating school to organise and run the proposed activity, event or programme;
 - b) Clarity and thought processes put into the execution of the proposed activity, event or programme;
 - c) Feasibility of the proposed activity, event or programme; and
 - d) Ability of the proposed activity, event or programme in creating a positive impact on their school environment.

Notwithstanding anything stated to the contrary herein, the Organiser retains a level of subjectivity in the evaluation of the Contest submissions.

- 11) Principal or teacher coordinator of the winning school will be notified via email, phone or through our local NGO partners. If a winner is not contactable within three (3) attempts, the Grant will be automatically forfeited.
- 12) The Grant will be given either via cheque or bank transfer to the winning school’s account. Account details: bank name, registered account name/holder’s name, and account number shall be provided to facilitate bank transfer.
 - a) The winning school must attach a bank statement in which transactions are blurred out except for the header, name of bank, account name, and account number. This is to ensure that their account is active, valid and the payment will go through.

- b) The winning school must also attach a copy of the Organiser's vendor form with all the needed details filled out and marked with the official school stamp.
- 13) In the event that an authorised school representative is appointed by the winning school to receive the Grant on behalf of the school, the individual representative shall provide a letter of authorization issued by the said winning school together with his/her personal account details such as: bank name, registered account name/holder's name, and account number to facilitate bank transfer.
 - a) The authorised school representative should also attach a copy of the Organiser's vendor form with all the needed details filled out and marked with the official school stamp. Along with a copy of the authorised school representative's individual identity card or passport.
 - b) The authorised school representative must attach a bank statement in which transactions are blurred out except for the header, name of bank, account name, and account number. This is to ensure his/her account is active, valid and the payment will go through.
- 14) By participating in this Contest, the principals and teacher coordinators of the participating schools acknowledge and agree that the Organiser excludes all warranty and/or liability in connection with the the Contest. Schools shall assume full liability and responsibility in case of any liability, mishap, injury, loss, damage, claim or accident (including personal injury and/or death) resulting from their students' participation in the Contest. The Organiser shall not be held responsible for any liability, mishap, loss, damage, claim or accident (including personal injury and/or death) in any manner whatsoever suffered by the students as a result of their participation in the Contest.
- 15) Unless otherwise specified, all ancillary costs are the school's responsibility.
- 16) If this Contest is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Organiser, in such event the Organiser reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the Contest, as appropriate, without prior notice.
- 17) The Organiser reserves the right to amend any of these terms and conditions at any time without prior notice and the amended terms and conditions will be uploaded onto the Contest Site. The principals, teacher coordinators and students of participating schools are therefore encouraged to visit the Contest Site from time to time to view any amendments and/or changes to these Terms and Conditions.
- 18) In view of the implementation of the Personal Data Protection Act 2010 of Malaysia, the principals and teacher coordinators of participating schools hereby expressly grant the Organiser and its affiliates the permission to use and process their personal data including (but not limited to) names, contact information and/or photographs (collectively,

“Personal Data”) for future advertising and publicity purposes. The principals and teacher coordinators of participating schools further agree to receive the latest information about products, news and events updates, rewards and promotions, special privileges and initiatives from the Organizer and its affiliates. - 19) All entry instructions and any other specific details relating to the Contest not specified herein shall form part of these Terms and Conditions.
- 20) The Organiser’s decisions are final and there shall be no appeal entertained and/or allowed. All participants shall not resort to court proceedings to review the Organiser’s decisions.
