PLEASE READ THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE PARTICIPATING IN THE CONTEST AS THEY CONTAIN BINDING LEGAL TERMS AND OBLIGATIONS INCLUDING LIMITATIONS OR EXCLUSION OF OUR LIABILITY. BY PARTICIPATING IN THE CONTEST, YOU ARE DEEMED TO UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN ITS ENTIRETY.

IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO ANY OF THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, YOU MUST NOT PROCEED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONTEST.

Terms & Conditions:

- 1) This Contest is open to all secondary and primary school students in Malaysia save and except for immediate family members (defined as parents, siblings, children or domestic partners, regardless of where they live) of the employees of the Organiser and the Contest’s sponsor, i.e.: **“SP Setia Berhad”**.
- 2) Participation is through schools only and submission must be stamped and signed by the respective school’s principal or teacher coordinator.
- 3) Each school may submit multiple entries for the Contest but each school is only eligible to win one (1) cash grant of RM1,000.00 only (**“Grant”**). Grant must be utilized for the purposes of this Contest and the winning schools have to submit their respective budget detailing their utilization of the Grant to the Organiser before the Grant will be disbursed by the Organiser.
- 4) The Contest will commence from 28 January 2019 at 09.00am and end on 19 March 2019 at 11.59pm (**“Submission Period”**). The final evaluation to facilitate the selection of the twenty (70) Grant winners will commence from 21 March 2019 at 7.00am and end on 23 March 2019 at 11.59pm.
- 5) To stand a chance to win the Grant, participating schools should ensure their students :
 - a) Ideate an activity, event, or programme which the students would like to execute during National Kindness Week which will start from 27 February 2019 and end on 19 March 2019 (**“Ideation”**).
 - b) Work on the Proposal either individually or in a group of not more than forty (40) students.
 - c) Follow the criteria(s) stated in the official #StandTogether website, more commonly known as “standtogether.my” (**“Contest Site”**).

- 6) Principals and teacher coordinators are not eligible to participate in the Contest but they may assist their students in their Contest submissions.
- 7) Schools are required to submit the students' kindness project ideas through the U-Report link provided by the Organizer.
- 8) Submission form must be complete failing which such submission will not be considered as a valid Contest entry and will automatically be rejected by the Organiser.
- 9) All submissions must be sent through Unicef's U-Report system or email to the Organiser's email address at alltherage@thestar.com.my during the Submission Period. Submission submitted through other mediums/methods will not be considered as a valid Contest entry and will automatically be rejected by the Organizer.
- 10) In order to stand a chance to win the Grand Prizes (as hereinafter defined), the twenty (20) Grant winners will have to:
 - a) Organise and run the activities, events or programmes as proposed in their respective Proposals during the National Kindness Week.
- 11) One (1) primary school and one (1) secondary school will be selected to receive the Grand Prizes.
- 12) Contest submissions will be judged based on the following criterias:-
 - a) Reasoning of why it is important for the participating school to organise and run the proposed activity, event or program;
 - b) Clarity and thought processes put into the execution of the activity, event or programme proposed;
 - c) Feasibility of their proposed activity, event or program; and
 - d) Ability of their proposed activity, event or program to make a positive impact on their school environment.

Notwithstanding anything stated to the contrary herein, the Organiser retains a level of subjectivity in the evaluation of the Contest submissions.

- 13) The Organizer may visit five (5) schools out of the twenty (20) Grant winning schools together with a celebrity during the National Kindness Week. The celebrities will come from a set of local talents who are also #StandTogether ambassadors.
- 14) The Grand Prize Winners for the Secondary and Primary category, will be chosen based on the presentation of their Kindness Project in their respective categories by a panel of selected judges at the Kindness Concert ("Concert") at the sole discretion of the

Organizer. Details of the additional prizes will be uploaded onto the Contest Site from time to time.

- 15) In the event of any prize being unavailable for any reason, the Organiser reserves the right to substitute the same with any other products of similar value. All prizes are non-transferable, non-refundable and non-exchangeable for cash or for any other prizes. All prizes are given on an "As Is, Where Is" basis.
- 16) Winners will be notified via email, phone or U-report platform. If a winner is not contactable within three (3) attempts, its prize will be automatically forfeited.
- 17) The Grand Prize must be claimed by an authorized representative of "Persatuan Ibu Bapa & Guru" or its equivalent ("**PIGB**") of the winning school from the Organiser's office located at Menara Star, 15, Jalan 16/11, Phileo Damansara II, 46350 Petaling Jaya, Selangor within three (3) months from the date of notification. The authorized representative of PIBG must present a letter of authorization issued by PIBG or the winning school in order to claim the Grand Prize.
- 18) The Grant will be given either via cheque or bank transfer to the PIBG's account or winning school's account. Account details: bank name, registered account name/holder's name, and account number to be provided to facilitate bank transfer.
 - a) The Grant winning school must also attach a bank statement in which transactions are blurred out except for the header, name of bank, account name, and account number. This is to ensure their account is active, valid and the payment will go through.
- 19) By participating in this Contest, the principals and teacher coordinators of the participating schools acknowledge and agree that the Organiser excludes all warranty and/or liability in connection with the awarded prizes and/or the Contest. Schools shall assume full liability and responsibility in case of any liability, mishap, injury, loss, damage, claim or accident (including personal injury and/or death) resulting from their students' participation in the Contest, redemption and/or usage of the prizes. The Organiser shall not be held responsible for any liability, mishap, loss, damage, claim or accident (including personal injury and/or death) in any manner whatsoever suffered by the students as a result of their participation in the Contest and/or the use of the prizes.
- 20) Unless otherwise specified, all ancillary costs are the school's responsibility.
- 21) If this Contest is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Organiser, in such event the Organiser reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to

modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the Contest, as appropriate, without prior notice.

- 22) The Organiser reserves the right to amend any of these terms and conditions at any time without prior notice and the amended terms and conditions will be uploaded onto the Contest Site. The principals, teacher coordinators and students of participating schools are therefore encouraged to visit the Contest Site from time to time to view any amendments and/or changes to the terms and conditions.
- 23) In view of the implementation of the Personal Data Protection Act 2010, the principals and teacher coordinators of participating schools hereby expressly grant the Organiser and its affiliates the permission to use and process their personal data including (but not limited to) names, contact information and/or photographs (collectively, "**Personal Data**") for future advertising and publicity purposes. The principals and teacher coordinators of participating schools further agree to receive the latest information about products, news and events updates, rewards and promotions, special privileges and initiatives from the Organizer and its affiliates. - 24) All entry instructions and any other specific details relating to the Contest and/or the prizes not specified herein shall form part of these Terms and Conditions.
